Ledger Lines are notes that extend above or below the staff.
(5 lines - 4 spaces)

- How to determine what the notes are:
1. Use the "every other" approach
 2. Use the sentences

These treble and bass notes are the same string on the harp.

F-A-C G-B-D Its line-line line notes or space space space notes.

1 octave lower

#1 The "every other" approach

⇒ C

These 1-3-5 chords are every other string on the harp.

Notice the sentences for the line and space notes are now reversed. As notes go up the staff, what was on a line is now on a space etc.
